**Roosevelt Price Jr.** has been incarcerated for 20 years, serving a sentence for second degree murder. He has a 22 year old daughter and a 21 year old son as well as a granddaughter and a grandson. Roosevelt has changed his thinking while incarcerated. He went from taking a life, to almost losing his life, to saving lives.

He shares his story while facilitating Impact of Crime on Victims (ICVC) and Criminal Thinking classes, helping other prisoners to understand how they have impacted their families, victims and communities.

From earning his GED, to completing numerous trades, to certification by the Library of Congress as a Braille Transcriber, Roosevelt has reached many of the goals he set for himself. He's been employed at the Braille and Narration Center at JCCC since 2004. A member of the NAACP prison branch since 2005, he is a recent past President of Branch 4072. Roosevelt is trying desperately to get out of prison so that he can be a kidney donor for his father.
